With many new brothers and sisters joining us from the Democratic Republic of the Congo, we are in need of more receivers so that everyone who comes might be able to hear the gospel in a language they understand. Connection Cards— The purple connection card found in your bulletin is a good way to communicate with the church! If you'd like to talk with someone, our Director of Outreach Ministry will be happy to speak with you following the service at the Welcome Center. The connection card can also be used to communicate a variety of other things with the church.

Childcare— Is provided by a qualified professional during the worship service, for children birth to 2 years old in the nursery. The nursery is the first room on the left as you go down the main hallway.

Children's Worship— During the worship service, for 3 years old through third grade in Rooms #15 & #21. Children may come forward for the Blessing of the Children, then follow the leaders to their room.

Holy Communion— We celebrate the Lord's Supper weekly. All who wish to receive God's grace are invited to receive Holy Communion. You may come forward to the front of the church to receive, or if you are unable to come forward, a communion server can come to you. The communion elements are bread & grape juice.

Giving— Those wishing to give tithes, offerings, or other financial giving may bring them forward at the time of Holy Communion and place in the offering plates. If you are unable to come forward, the communion server can receive your offerings. You can also give online at buechelchurch.org

Prayer Ministry & Requests— The back of the Connection Card serves as a prayer card. Please fill in the prayer card and return it in the offering plate or to an usher. During Holy Communion, a minister will be available at the front of the church to pray with all those who desire prayer, for any reason.

Restrooms— Are available, as you exit the sanctuary, to your left, through two sets of double doors.

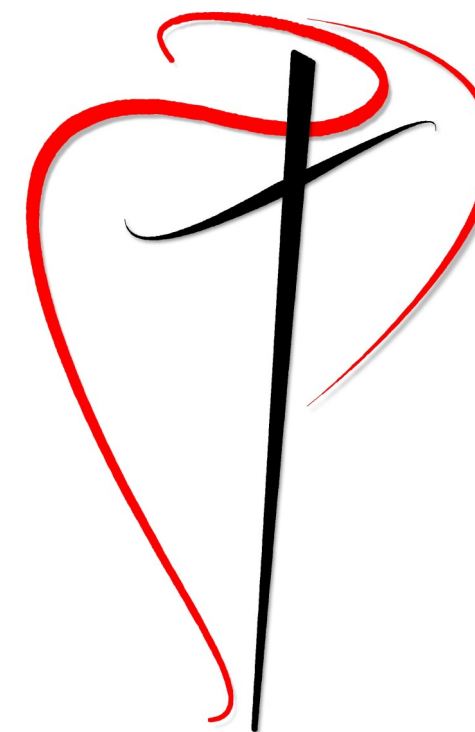
